# Relationships Impacted by the Revised Treaty

- First, there is a question of the rights and obligations of the Community, and the constituents of the Community, between and among themselves i.e. CARICOM, its Member States, and Community nationals;

# Relationships Impacted by the Revised Treaty

- Second, the Caribbean Community, as an International Legal Person, has legal significance for other subjects of International Law, including Member States, non-Member States and International Organizations; and

# Relationships Impacted by the Revised Treaty

- Third, the simultaneous co-existence of the Revised Treaty constituting the Community alongside the national legal systems of Member States, and in particular the Constitutions of these Member States, is worthy of enquiry.
